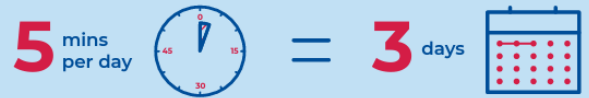

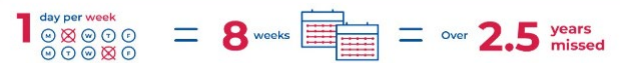

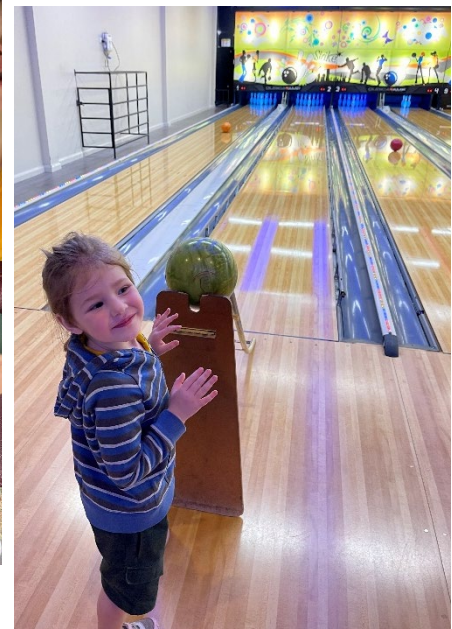
Ivy
