Sun Safety

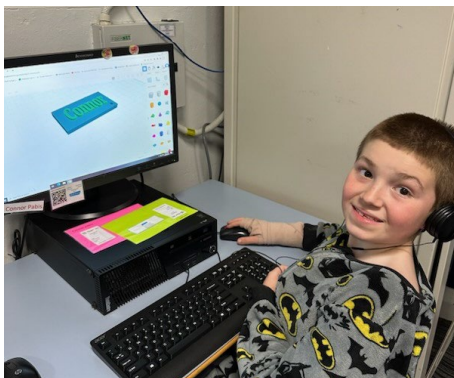
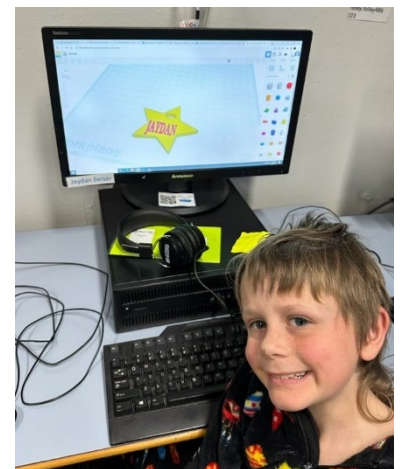
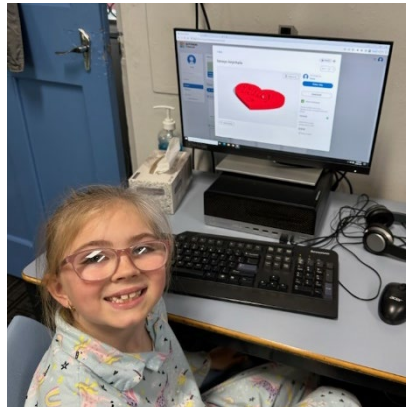
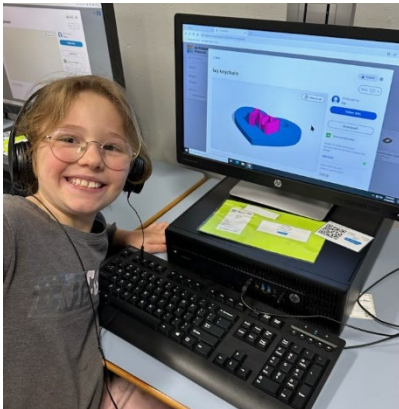
Wearing a hat is very important practice for sun safety. If your child has no hat no play outside, they will need to stay under cover in the cola.
